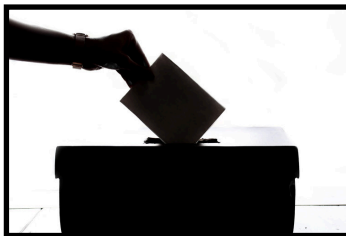

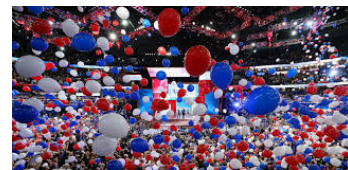
## COMBINED MAY/JUNE BREAKFAST
